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Background of the legislation for PA services	<p>Law from 2005 : http://www.legifrance.gouv.fr/affichTexte.do?cidTexte=JORFTEXT000000809647 Decret on n. 2005 1591 and modified in june 2006 "Prestation de compensation du Handicap Aide humaine" (Personnal assistance) : http://www.legifrance.gouv.fr/affichTexte.do?cidTexte=JORFTEXT000000454080&dateTexte=&categorieLien=id</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Time frame of the development of the legislation : from 2002 to 2005 but the revision process of 1975's legislation started already before. - Development of the type of legislation: the general type of legislation includes all aspects of the life of people with disabilities. - Role of IL in the lobby for legislation reform: The IL principles at the time were mainly put forward by the future CHA members. - Ideological conflicts in the lobby process: The main ideological conflicts rested in the differences between organizations, managing institutions and services and those managing no institutions and services. - Is the legislative in accordance with ENIL IL principles: Only in part as P.A is not granted based on the assessment of the real needs of people.
Type of legislation	<p>Law from 2005 providing for hours of PA is based on the needs of the disabled person but is not specifically devoted to PA. For example: article 54 concerns the use of guide dogs.</p>
Administrator of PA services	<p>MDPH (Maison Départementale des Personnes Handicapées), a new structure created by the law 2005. There is one in every department. The role of the MDPH is to determine how many hours of PA services a disabled person needs. The sum is then paid directly to the disabled person according to their choice between services, direct payment or family assistance.</p>
Funder of services	<p>National funds distributed to the departments by the CNSA (Caisse Nationale de Solidarité et de l'Autonomie, up to 34 % only) which collects the funding during the national solidarity day (journée de solidarité) a day during which employees donate money to the national solidarity fund.</p>

Disabilities covered	All disabilities when there is a need.
Amount of hours per day/week possible	Up to 24 hours per day, exceptionally some CHA members have 26 hours or even up to 32 hours per day. The double assistance is for tasks such as lifting which require two persons.
Assessment of needs: tool and how often	The tool is a form of about 40 pages called GEVA - Guide d'EVALuation. The MDPH decides how often there should be a reassessment and it should take place at least once every 10 years.
Hourly rate funded	From 3,47€/h for the family to 17,59€/h for a service of PA. A deaf person receives 358.8€/month and a blind person 598€/month.
Age requirement	0-60 years old and more than 60 years old if the disability is known before
