Background of the legislation	
Type of legislation	The only PA related texts are in the Law of Social Protection and are called “Home care”. To be more specific, it’s called “Assistance/help at home”.

Disabilities covered	Elderly people – The legislation covers mostly for elderly people but disabled people are also included, the aid given is not provided by professionals, except the social workers, psychologists and nurses the majority of the people working in this program are not trained, they only provide services like, helping in the housekeeping, cooking, shopping, etc
Possible amount of hours per day/week of PA	Not more than 3-4 hours daily, mostly in the morning and during working days.

4. Hourly rate funded	Average amount of 800 euro per month paid as pension within which there is a certain amount for “PA” but no actual PA scheme. The amount depends on the agency of social insurance, the amount of 800 euros is not respected with the highest amount given at this moment being 640 euros.
